Your Partner When Taking Part in Research

The Institutional Review Board (IRB) helps to protect you in research studies. They make sure that you understand what your study is about and that the benefits of the study are greater than the risks!

Before a study is approved, the IRB asks:

- Are the study activities as safe as possible?
- Are the risks reasonable compared with the benefits?
- Are the study materials complete and easy to understand?



Before Taking Part in A Study, Learn About the . . .

Context:

Learning the goal and requirements of a study can help you understand if you are a good fit!

Commitment:

Learning what the study wants you to do can help you see if the study is worth your time and energy!

Community:

Learning how a study can improve your condition and community health can help you decide if the study is right for you!
