Award Description and Eligibility

- Named for three renowned UGA professors, these awards recognize mid-career faculty whose research, creative activities, and scholarly achievements at UGA have gained nation and international recognition, placing the recipient at the forefront of his or her field, in one of three discipline areas:
 - Humanities and the Arts; the Albert Christ-Janer Award
 - Natural Sciences and Engineering; the Lamar Dodd Award
 - Social and Behavioral Sciences; the William A. Owens Award
- Up to one award per discipline annually
- Prize: \$2,500 and framed art print
- Eligibility: Associate professors and full professors within 3 years of promotion
- Residency: Must have been in residence at UGA for at least three years

Nomination Requirements

- Nominations must be made by the Dean, or Director if nominee's primary appointment is to a Center/Institute
- No limit to the number of nominations a particular Dean/Director may submit, but units are strongly encouraged to rank nominees and put forth only the strongest candidates

Nomination Materials and Submission Procedure

- Compile the following nomination materials in the order listed below into a single PDF application file:
 1. Dean/Director nomination letter (≤3 pages) to include:
 - Nominee name, rank, and date of faculty appointment at UGA
 - Name of award and discipline area for which nominee is put forth
 - Summary of nominee's qualifications, as well as specific examples; evidence will vary by discipline but may include publications, performances, inventions, etc.
 2. Brief bios (≤1 page total) of the 3 required referees (see below), demonstrating suitability for evaluation of nominee
 3. 3 letters of recommendation (≤3 pages each)
 - At least 2 letters must be from external referees; letters written in support of nominee's promotion dossier are acceptable
 - Must be dated within the past 3 years (as of application deadline)
 4. Nominee's curriculum vitae
- Submit single PDF application file electronically via the [online submission form](#).

Evaluation and Selection Process

- Nomination packages are reviewed by a discipline-specific committee of faculty
 - Up to one nominee for each discipline is selected
- Recommendations are provided to the vice president for research who makes the final selections
