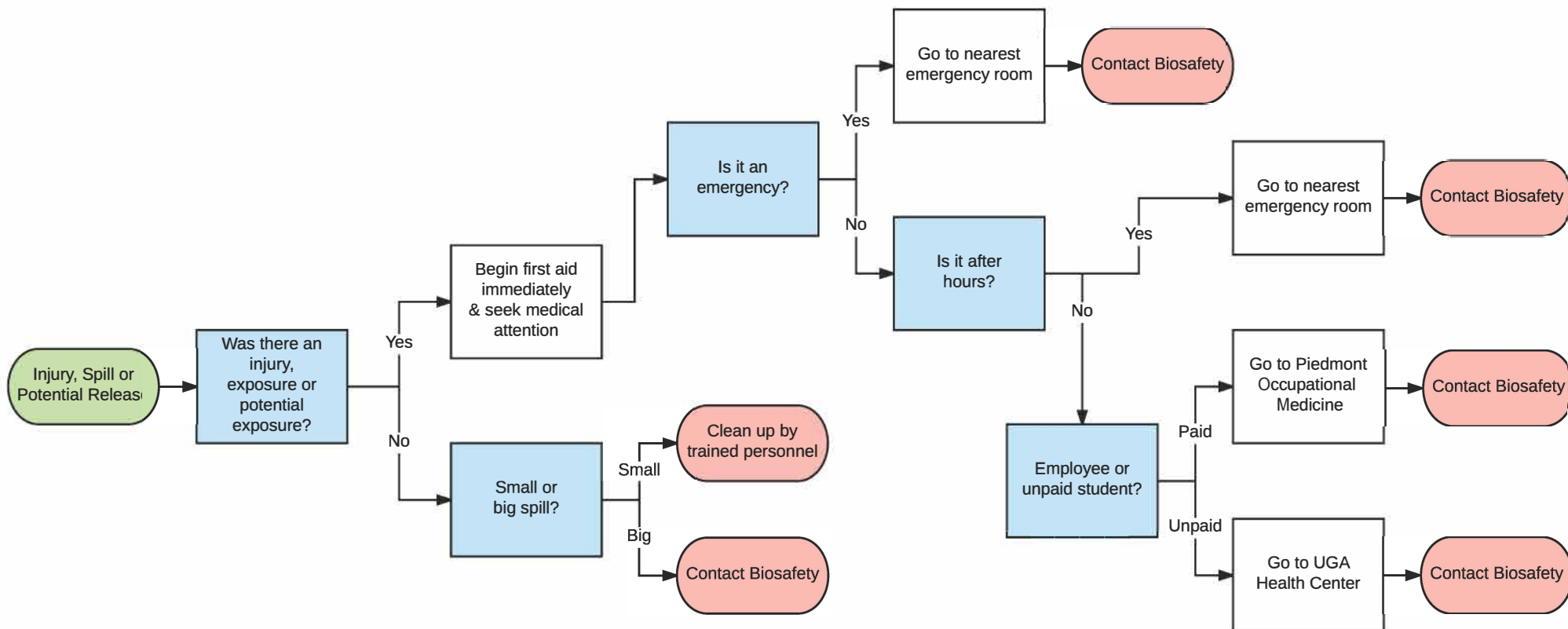


BIOHAZARDOUS INCIDENT: INJURY, SPILL OR POTENTIAL RELEASE RESPONSE



FIRST AID

Percutaneous injury: wash the affected area with hand soap and water for 15 minutes.

Aerosol exposure: do not inhale; immediately leave the room.

Splash to face: flush affected area in eyewash continuously for 15 minutes.
