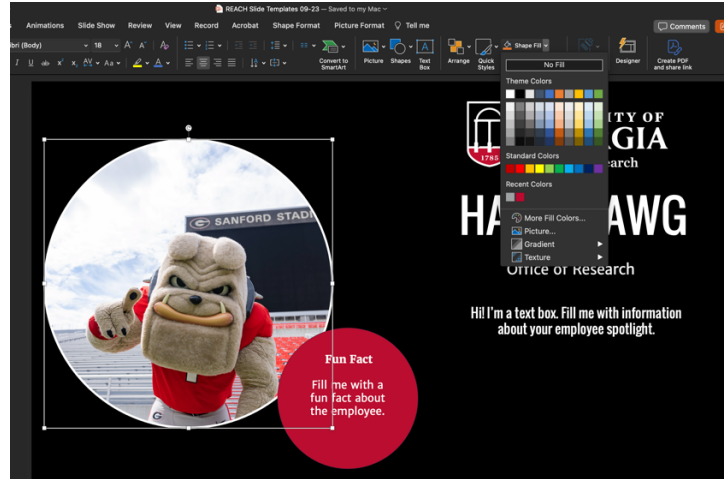


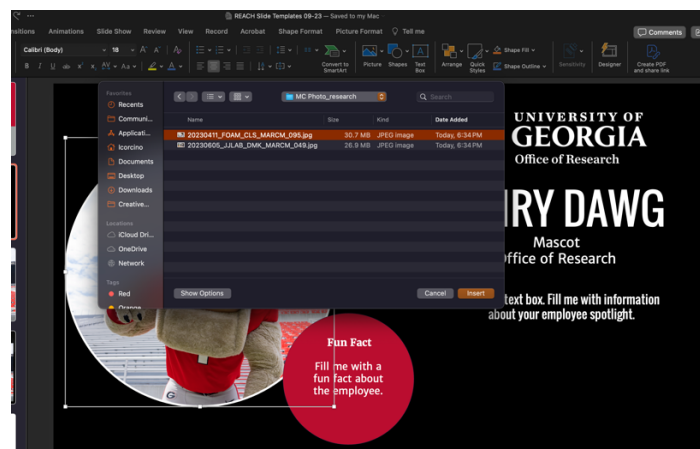
Replacing images inside of a shape in PowerPoint



1.) Select the shape that you would like to change the image.



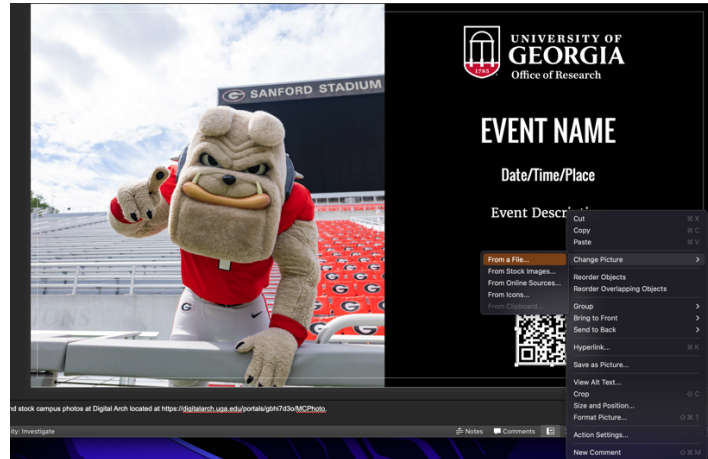
2.) Go to Shape Fill in the top right hand of the toolbar. Once you have selected Shape Fill, go down and select Picture.



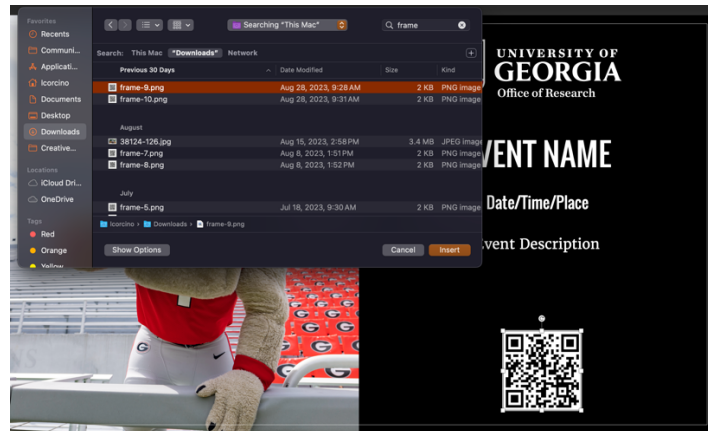
3.) Find and select the image you would like to use and select Insert to replace the image.

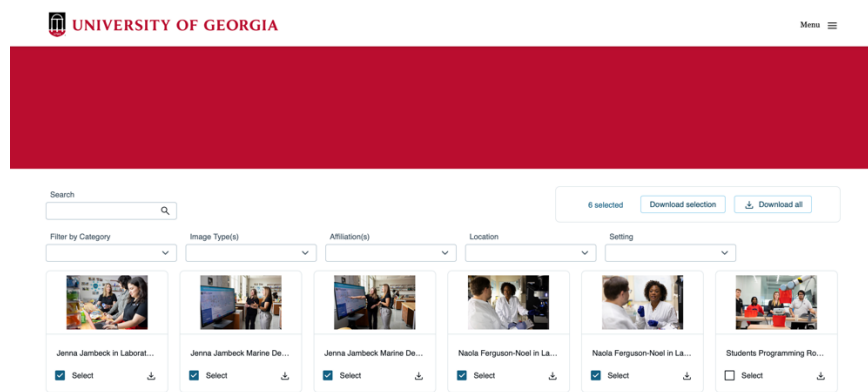

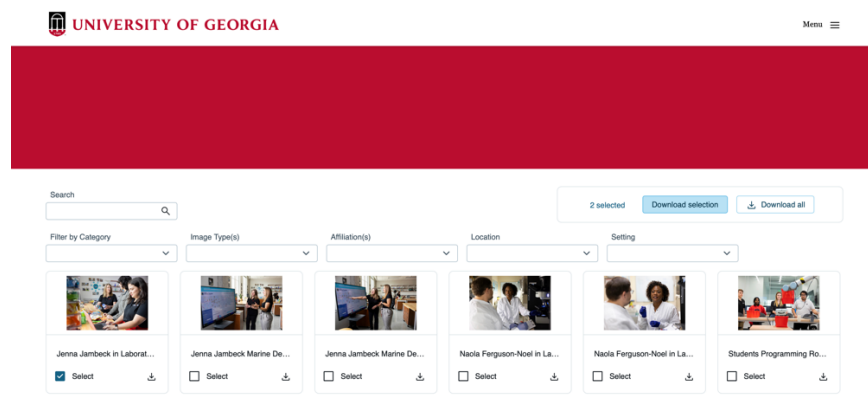
2.) Find and select your downloaded QR code and click enter to replace it in the PowerPoint slide.

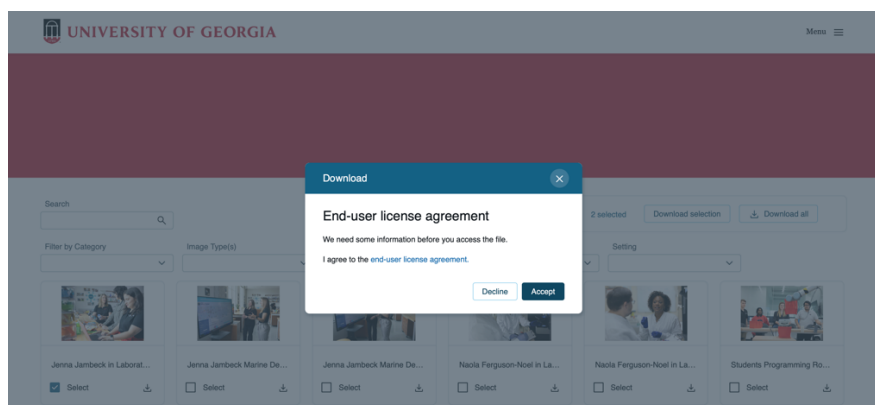
