Noncompliance: Lapse in Approval and Past Due Progress Reports

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Which is Which

Continuing Review

- Has an expiration date
- Usually more than minimal risk
- DOJ funded studies still require continuing review
- Most are STUDYs (pre-2018 Common Rule)

Progress Report

- No expiration date
- PROJECTs
- Minimal risk
 - Exempt-5 years
 - Expedited-3 years



Notifications

- 90, 60, and 30 day portal reminders
- Email notification that approval expired or progress report is due now
- IT Report when portal fails to send reminder



The Process

STUDY & PROJECT-EXEMPT

- 1.2-week reminder
- 2.30 days past due-public comment that study will be closed
- 3.1-week later-admin close and track (RNI for federally funded)



The Process Cont.

STUDY & PROJECT-NonExempt Continuing Review & Progress Report

Not Federally Funded

- 1. 2 week- reminder
- 2. 30 days past due- RNI
- 3. 1 week later- Dept Head letter
- 4. 1 week later- Create RNI for board, send to Marie to add to IRB agenda

Federally Funded

- 1. 1 week- reminder
- 2. 1 week later- RNI
- 3. 1 week later- Dept Head letter
- 30 days past due- Create RNI for board, send to Marie to add to IRB agenda



The Process Cont.

Full Board

1. Lapsed 1 day ago but less than 31 days ago

- 1. Email PI and copy DH
- 2. RNI required

2. 31+ days lapsed

- 1. Email DH and copy PI
- 2. RNI required
- 3. Goes to the board for termination



IRB Responsibilities

- Suspension
- Termination
- Serious non-compliance
- Continuing non-compliance
- Non-compliance that neither serious or continuing
