Veterinary services provided by URAR veterinarians and veterinary technicians will be charged at published rates in the following cases:

1. If the treatment option mutually agreed upon by PI and URAR veterinary staff exceeds the threshold for routine preventative and acute care veterinary services covered by the per diem rate.
2. If no URAR per diems are being recovered for the animals for which veterinary services are provided.
3. If the per diem rate for the species does not include routine preventative veterinary care (NHP only).

These charges are billed as a fee-for-service activity as the service is provided. Other arrangements can be made, such as contracting annually for veterinary services or subsidizing salaries of veterinary staff, if the full cost of rendering these services is recovered.

Please note that these veterinary service charges include only time and expertise. Drugs, supplies, and animal transportation costs, if any, will be billed as separate line items and as shown on the service fees rate sheet.

The aim of these guidelines is to ensure that no subsets of researchers subsidize the research of others, as directed by the NIH Cost Analysis and Rate Setting Manual and OMB A-21.
