Teaming for Interdisciplinary Research Pre-Seed Program

Provides “pre-seed” funding to facilitate formation of faculty teams. Funding levels are sufficient to support modest travel, graduate student assistance.

Presidential Interdisciplinary Seed Grants

Sponsored the Office of Research and the Office of the Vice President for Public Service and Outreach, this program awards more significant funding and has been highly successful in supporting projects that attract subsequent external support.

Leading Large Integrative Research Teams (L2-IRT) Workshop

Workshop series that helps faculty take the next step and lead large integrative research teams. Participants learn best practices in leadership, team science and organizational strategy research.

Major Integrative Proposal Planning (MIPP) Award

Provides faculty team leaders with time and comprehensive support for effective planning, development, submission and launch of large-scale integrative proposals.

Office for Proposal Enhancement

Provides technical, skilled support to faculty developing research proposals for external funding.

Research Training Support Group

Collaboration between the Graduate School, Office of Institutional Diversity and Office of Research. Supports faculty in securing and executing externally funded grants for innovative training of a diverse research workforce.

Team Impact Award

Part of the annual UGA Research Awards, this honor was created to recognize UGA research teams for excellence in innovative, impactful scholarship.

Facilitates and supports research teams of faculty, staff and students in meeting needs and requirements of U.S. mission agencies and industry.
